下午，他們一起清理垃圾。最後大家開心地乘車回家。



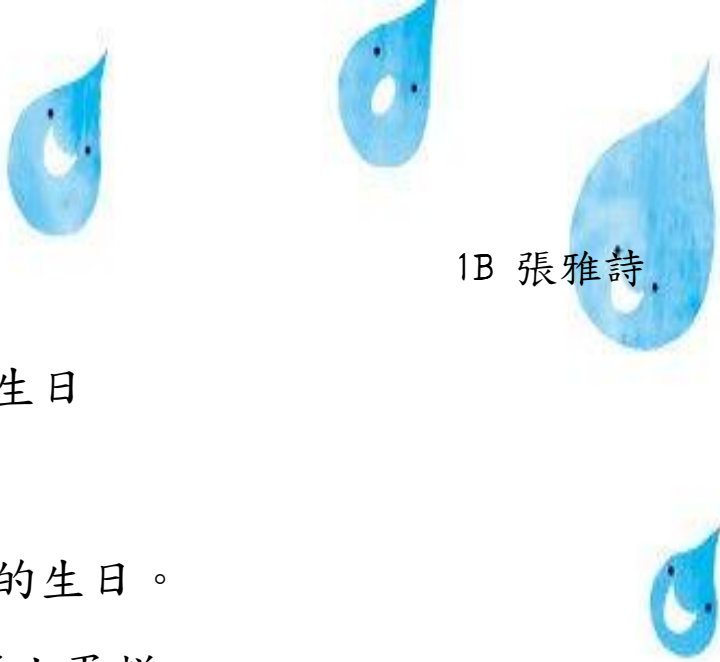

樂兒拉着媽媽的手，感到十分快樂。



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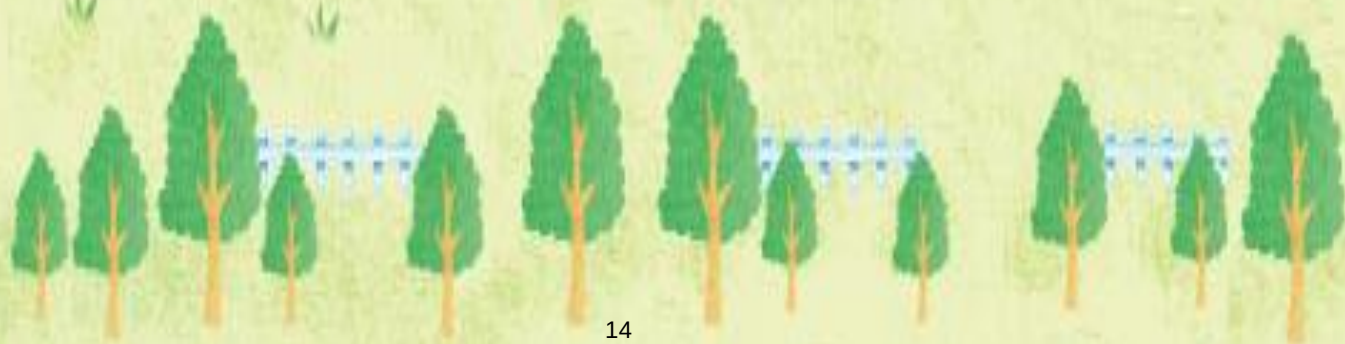
做手工比賽

大會宣佈比賽結果，子明取得冠軍。他得到了一張獎狀，子明和媽媽都感到很高興。



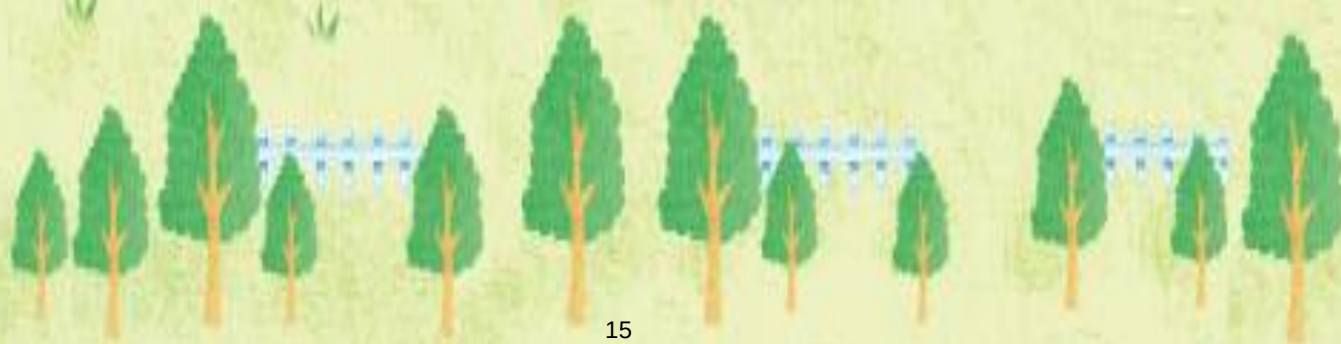

山羊媽媽找到小山羊後感到很開心，她跟小山羊說：「你以後要跟着媽媽，不要再自行離開。」



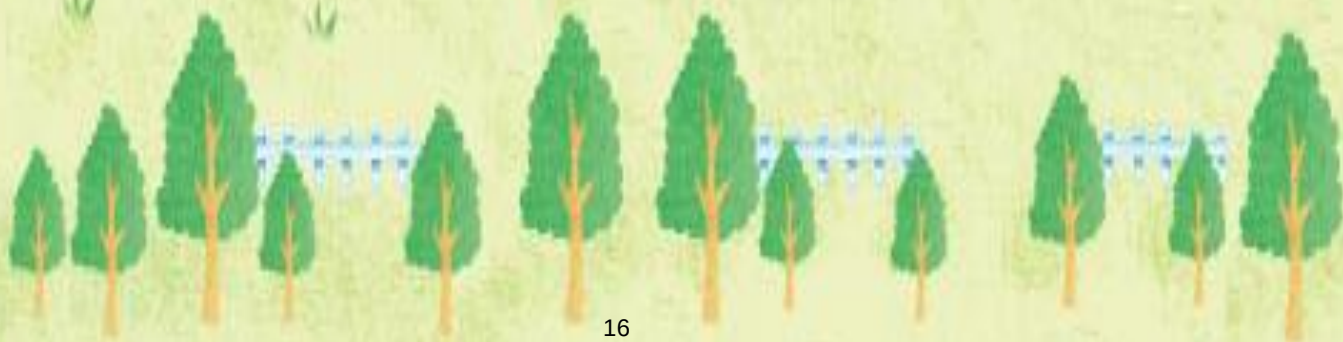

A Fun Place in Hong Kong

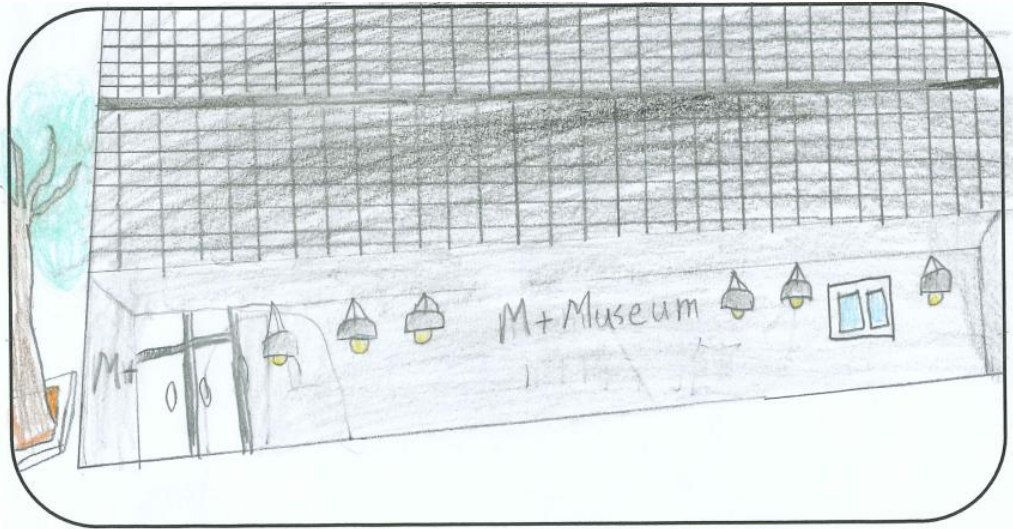

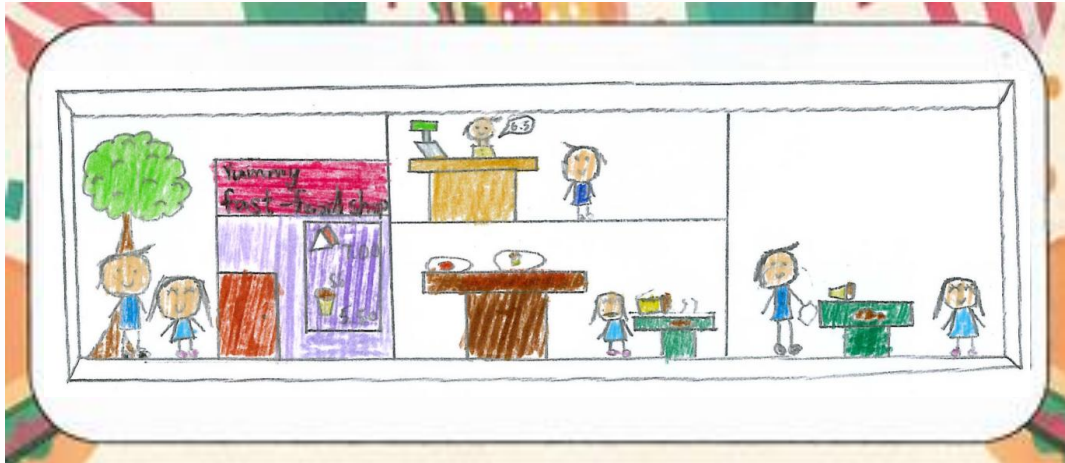

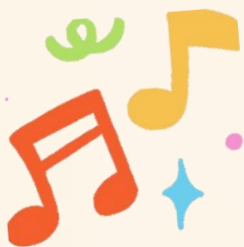

Do I like Jasper? Of course! I like Jasper because we share our things and play with each other.



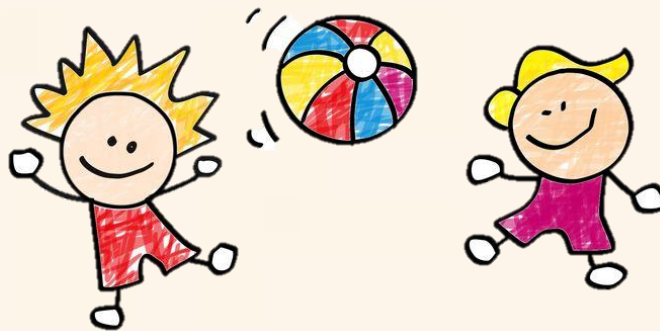
My Leisure Activity

Sunny

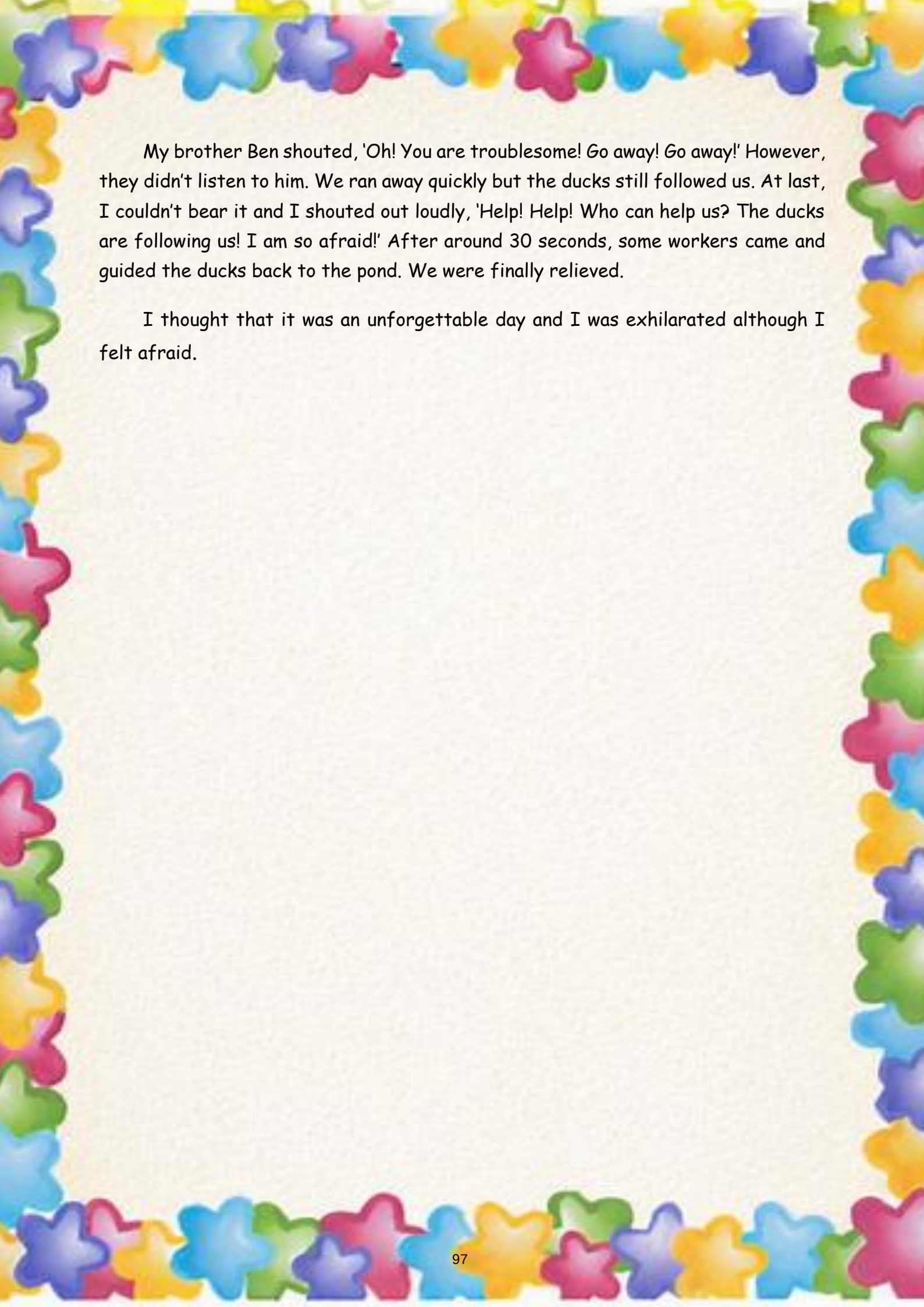

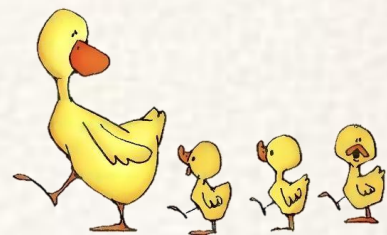

My grandma misses her old days because she had a good relationship with her neighbors. Although surfing the Internet is convenient, we should contact each other more in the real world.

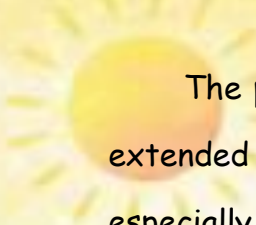
Movie Review Star Wars II

Star Wars Attack on the clones is directed by British animator Dave Filoni. The Science Fiction film is about war, morality, loyalty, friendship and the harsh struggle between the weakling good and the strength-getting evil.

The cast has worked hard on the film especially the main characters, which include Anakin Skywalker with the Jedi robes, short dark hair along with a confident expression, Obi-Wan Kenobi who is wise, patient, strategic and responsible and Captain Rex in adulthood with white clone armor. He is loyal, brave, disciplined but thinks independently. As for my favourite character, the spot goes to Ahsoka Tano. She has blue eyes with a white facial marking. Her determination to defeat the empire is like a river carving through stone, never giving up even when things are tough. She grows like a sapling in a storm. Tested, bent but never broken.

The film is about a war between galaxies. Soldiers fight with ray guns and lightsabers while spacecrafts and AM03-D1 fighting jets travel at the speed of light. In the Milky Way, they try to protect their allies and defeat the army of the dark. Battles happen on planets and space, as Anakin and Ahsoka were given an important mission to rescue the son of Lord Jabba to prove they are with his side.

The climax is immersive. It is about the attack on base 411 at a planet named Tatooine, which is the home of their allies, called the grogestans. Anakin and Ahsoka will have to deliver Jabba's son safely while facing a trap sent by Dooka's agents. They have to fight superstitious drones, light-speed bomber squads, and eight million clones that outnumber and overwhelm those two. Sacrifices may have to be made. Although they suffered casualties and losses, they have proved something you don't want to miss!



The plot was straightforward and action-packed, though it serves more as an extended pilot for the series. The acting is ok. There are strong voice performances, especially Ashley Eckstein when Ahsoka solos 20 clone clones by herself. Amazing visual effects. Bright, stylized 3D animations. It 'brings the era to life' with their exciting battles. Sound effects feel intense and immersive as the lightsaber slices and droids fly. The theme song is classic star wars and it matches with the film. Also, the cinematography is surprising. The tech of the motion-picture definitely outstands other films.

I would strongly recommend this science-fiction film. If you are a fan of action, or stories about teamwork and mentorship, you'll enjoy this movie. Consequently, it is not as deep as the main saga films, but still delivers exciting battles, classic Star War spirit and sets up one of the best animated ones in the franchises.

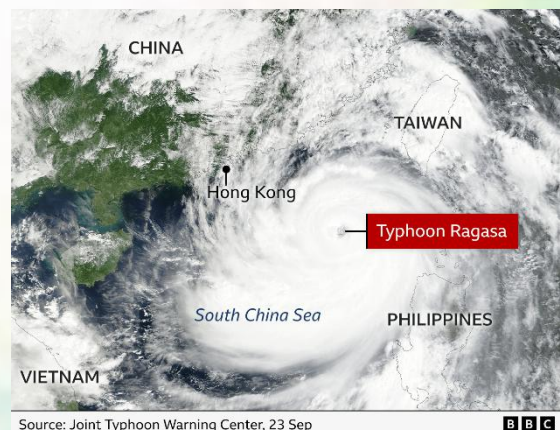

Day 1

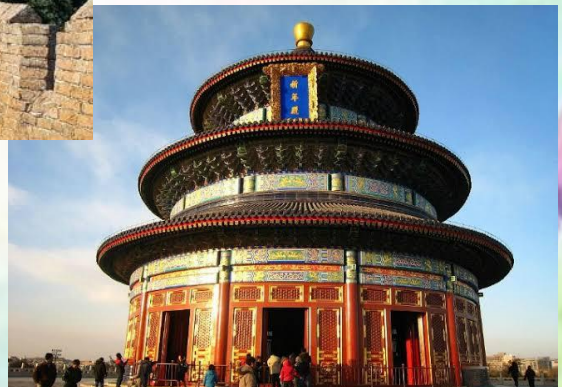
In the morning, we first went to the Great Wall where it was very lively, big and beautiful. Therefore, it is very popular. It is a historical building which is huge and beautiful.

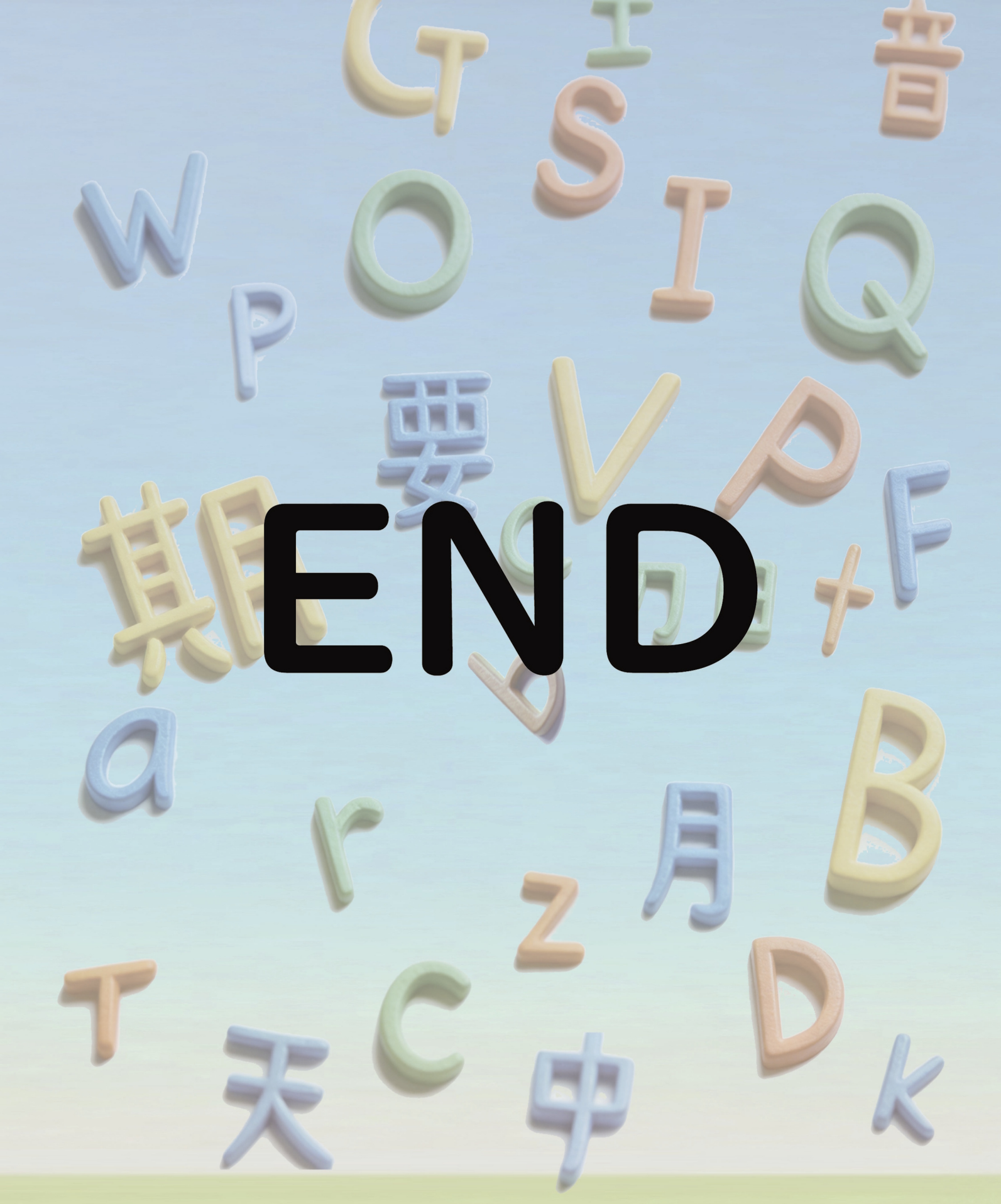
